
Installation Guide

NOTE: This instruction sheet is for informational purposes only. Your working environment may differ from what is shown in the pictures. Please determine location of wiring and plumbing before you begin.

It is your responsibility to ensure proper installation and, if in doubt, contact customer service.

While our products are designed for homeowner installation, you assume all risk associated with the installation process. If you so choose you may refer to our video (<https://youtu.be/ha9JVN3v4Ho>) for these instructions.

Please be sure to check all hardware is present. The below picture shows some typical hardware but is not a complete list. Depending on how your order was designed pieces may vary. Please refer to the parts list that was sent with your order to verify all pieces are accounted for.



You will also need some tools. We recommend the following:

- Power Drill
- Screwdriver
- Level



You may also need a saw to make cuts, particularly if your system uses a bridge shelf and needs to be cut to size.

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Your doors will come with a two piece hinge:



The hinge snaps into place and latches on to the hinge plate. These may be installed separately or together depending on your preference. Insert the hinges into the predrilled holes as shown:



Measure and locate the location of the plates based on your technical drawings. Insert the wing plates and secure them to your panels:



After snapping the hinges into place you can adjust them to the desired reveals. There are two screws for adjustment. The first screw pictured adjusts the left and right position of the door:

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The second screw at the back adjusts the in and out location of the door:



Adjust the alignment until you are satisfied.
